



LANGUAGES

Nigeria's official language is English, but there are more than 520 different languages and dialects spoken throughout the country. Almost everyone will speak or understand some English, and most Nigerians living in the urban centers speak it fluently.

BUSINESS AND SHOPPING

Monday through Friday, public offices are open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and business hours are typically 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m but can go over till midnight. Most bars and hotels work 24/7. Tours can be booked via <https://tournigeria.gov.ng/#tour>

CLIMATE

In April, Abuja usually has extremely high temperatures and moderate rainfall. Throughout the day, temperatures typically settle at around 35°C. But by evening, they drop to around 25°C. Remember, these are typical temperatures, and certain days could be even hotter. Ensure you wear appropriate clothing to handle the warmth

CURRENCY

The naira is Nigeria's national currency. You'll find, however, that in airports, hotels, and tourist destinations, USD is commonly accepted. The exchange rates used will vary, though, so it's worth checking you're getting a fair deal before you exchange. Major providers such as Visa, Mastercard/Maestro/Cirrus, and Amex are accepted in ATMs, shops and restaurants. However, it's a good idea to keep some local cash with you, for smaller purchases, tipping, and in the event you find yourself somewhere where cards aren't accepted. Don't forget to tell your home bank you're going to be travelling.

HEALTH & EMERGENCIES

Visitors from or passing through a yellow fever and cholera zone (most of tropical Africa and South America) must produce a valid International Certificate of Vaccination for Yellow Fever. All travellers to Nigeria do not need any proof of vaccination, recovery, or testing against COVID-19. There are several public and private hospitals and clinics in most major cities. Travelers should carry an adequate supply of their prescribed medicines.
