DEFINITION

- **Healthcare integration:**
 - typically refers to a comprehensive approach to healthcare that considers various factors and disciplines to provide holistic and patient-centered care.
- **Integrated Regulation**
 - involves establishing and enforcing rules and standards to ensure the coordination and quality of healthcare services across different providers and settings.
