A case of an Intern Dr X.Y. Graduated from a Medical School in West Africa English-Speaking Country.

Internship: November 2022 in Obstetric and Gynaecology at the Jackson F. Doe Regional Referral Hospital, Nimba County.

Report file by the Consultant on June 12, 2023:

Fundamental difficulty in understanding essential basic medical terminologies at intern level.

Lack of understanding of patient's record and proper documentation, also inadequate record keeping.

Difficulties in understanding medical literatures or research papers for unit presentation during seminars.



Difficulty working within a team.

He feels his suggestions are always correct and should be recognized

Whenever he is on call, he escapes work often.







The Intern was forwarded to the Psychiatric for assessment, treatment and recommendation(s) at the E S Grant Mental Health Hospital, JFKMC.



Diagnosis: Personality traits consistent with Narcissistic Personality disorder.



Recommendation: Psychological Intervention including Cognitive Behavior Therapy.



Had several sessions of psychotherapy

But realizing Narcissistic Personality treatment difficulty, the followings were recommended:

Internship resumption for possible performance evaluation

Continual psychotherapy

Given specific tasks and unique rules to follow

Re-evaluation and necessary intervention to improve his actions and inactions.



The Intern was reassigned to resume internship – Internal Medicine

November 8, 2024, formal complaint was made against the Intern in question by a patient.

Intern: "what is wronged with you?"



Patient: "I am having weakness, vomiting, loss of appetite and fever".

Intern: he looked at her and in a very loud tone, he asked: "does water leak from your vagina? When was the last time you saw your period?"

Intern: "you are a foolish and stupid person".

Patient and partner file a complaint due to his unprofessional behavior.



While the Hospital was investigating the complaint, another complaint was filed against the same Intern – November 19, 2024

Alleged sexual misconduct against a minor – patient's daughter, who provided care for her mother on admission.

He coerces the daughter and she visited his home 3 times in the space of one month.



The Intern is currently on suspension pending Investigation for the alleged sexual misconduct by the John F. Kennedy Medical Center Management.

The Liberia Medical and Dental Council is awaiting the report from the Investigations for decision.

Important question: Pending the outcome of the investigation, what should LMDC do based on the previous reports from both teaching hospitals?
